**APPLICATION FOR A DIPLOMA FOR  
 WORLD WAR II, KOREAN WAR, AND VIETNAM WAR ERA VETERANS**

*School boards of school districts maintaining a secondary school are authorized to award a high school diploma to World War II, Korean War, and Vietnam War Era veterans without one.*

**ELIGIBILITY**

*The veteran must have served during World War II (December 7, 1941 - December 31, 1946); or the Korean War Era (June 27, 1950 - January 31, 1955); or the Vietnam War Era (August 5, 1964 - May 7, 1975 for veterans serving outside Vietnam; February 28, 1961 to May 7, 1975 for veterans serving inside Vietnam); and must have been separated from military service with an “honorable” discharge; and must not already have a high school diploma.*

**INSTRUCTIONS**

*Complete the “Application” section below and mail it to the address above. Approved applications will be forwarded to the high school you selected. Disapproved applications will be mailed back to you. It is the responsibility of the applicant to prove their military service. The State of Vermont has the discharges of most veterans who entered the military from Vermont. However, we recommend you attach a copy of your discharge to ensure quicker processing. Please print legibly and complete all blocks.*
